



DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

1. Uniform is to be worn as intended. Please discourage students from rolling up or down any uniform item.
2. Closed in shoes for ALL students.
3. NO HATS to be worn inside classrooms.
4. Only items of College dress purchased through Tudor Uniforms may be worn. Any other item is unacceptable e.g. Non-pleated skirts.
5. Students may wear other tops under their college shirts provided no part of the 'undershirt' is visible below the college shirt sleeves or below the bottom of the college shirt. Visibility at the neck is acceptable, but with no brand name words showing on neck bands. Any student wearing coloured undershirts which show below the college shirt bottom or sleeves will be required to remove them.
6. No belts or style waist decorations are acceptable at any time.
7. Students have a fairly free range of choice with socks, but only plain nude coloured stockings can be worn, other than socks, with shorts or skirts. **No leggings or footless tights are allowed.**
8. Ugg boots of any form are not acceptable.
9. In the winter or cooler weather, only college jumpers or jackets may be worn around the college.
10. Jewellery may be worn, but if it is deemed a health hazard, and against OSH standards, then it must be removed.
11. PE uniforms and Dance and Drama clothing is only appropriate when students are in those specific classes. It should not be worn at any other time.

Uniform choices include:

- 3 styles of shorts
- 2 styles of pants
- 1 skirt
- 1 short sleeve shirt
- 1 short sleeve blouse
- 1 waterproof jacket
- 1 hooded windcheater
- 1 cardigan
