

## 52824WA Certificate II in Building & Construction Pathway- Trades (Painting Pre Apprenticeship) – School Based

MPA Skills offer a Pre-Apprenticeship for those still attending school and want to participate in the program during Year 11 and Year 12. The Certificate II qualification counts towards a student's final results at school including the work experience component. The Pre Apprenticeship course is a great 'first step' into the trade industry. This qualification will give you the basic knowledge of the trade, and it will make you look more desirable to potential Painting employers.

### How long does the Cert II Painting Pre Apprenticeship go for?

The Painting Pre Apprenticeship runs from terms 1-3 in 2020. You will attend school 4 days per week, and attend an MPA Skills training campus on either a Thursday or Friday depending on which campus you choose.

### Will I complete Work Experience?

Yes! You will go out on site with a qualified Painter during your course to complete a minimum of 125 hours of work experience. MPA Skills will find the employer for you in the first few weeks of the course.
