



DRESS CODE POLICY

Mindarie Senior College has a Dress Code Policy determined in consultation with parents and students. **All students attending the College must wear the full College uniform as sold by the College** and are not allowed to modify the uniform, nor wear it in an inappropriate way. Hats are not to be worn inside the College buildings. Students and parents will be informed of arrangements to purchase the uniform after confirmation of enrolment. The uniform can be ordered and purchased from Tudor School Uniforms throughout the year.

Students who are in breach of the College Dress Code must report to Student Services upon arrival at the College. Students will then be subject to the following consequences:

1st offence – A uniform pass will be issued along with a lunch detention that day in U2. Students may be asked to go home and change uniforms if they are wearing inappropriate clothes or bright, non-College colours.

2nd offence – All consequences from the 1st offence; plus a Loss of Good Standing Stage 1(4 weeks) issued by the Learning Area Manager on detention duty. A message will be sent home notifying the parents.

3rd offence – If this occurs within the 4 weeks of LoGS 1, the student will be sent home via a temporary suspension, subject to a meeting with the parents. Loss of Good Standing will increase to Stage 2.

Any further breaches after this point will result in additional temporary suspensions.

Safe footwear is compulsory at Mindarie Senior College, and must be appropriate for the activity. Students are to wear closed-in shoes: thongs or backless shoes are not permitted.
