Local Intake Area Applications:

Please submit the completed enrolment package to the College by Wednesday **12 June 2024**.

Out of Area Applications:

Please submit the completed enrolment package on or before Friday **19 July 2024** if spaces are available, enrolment will be determined by (a) children who have siblings enrolled at the College for Year 12 2025 and (b) Children who live closest to the College. You will be contacted by 24 July 2024 to let you know whether we are able to offer an enrolment to your child for 2025.

Submitting your application

- Please complete all the documents in the enrolment package
- Enrolment form must be signed by parent/guardian and student
- Application can be submitted in person to Mindarie College or a **PDF document** emailed to Mindarie.SC.enrolment@education.wa.edu.au
- All supporting documents are required
- Only fully completed applications will be accepted

> ENROLMENT CHECKLIST

When you enrol a student at Mindarie Senior College please provide photocopies of the following (our staff are unable to provide photocopying services):

- ☐ Photocopies of two (2) different documents as proof of address e.g. utility bill, lease agreement, phone bill, driver's licence etc. (not a rates invoice)
- ☐ Photocopy of your child's birth certificate
- ☐ Current Australian Immunisation Register History Statement (see enrolment package for details)

If the student is not born in Australia, you must provide all of the following:

- ☐ Date of entry into Australia
- ☐ Copy of current visa documentation and passport
- ☐ Visa Sub Class number
- ☐ Visa Grant number
- ☐ Copy of Visa Grant Notice
- OR
- ☐ Citizenship Certificate
