#### Applying for a Mindarie Senior College Academic Scholarship

Scholarships can be awarded to students who are excelling in a particular subject area. Students should use the attached application form and guidelines to submit their scholarships to the College by the advertised deadline. Late applications cannot be accepted.

Students are encouraged to apply for multiple scholarships but, in the interests of diversity, can only be awarded a single scholarship.

Successful applicants will receive a conditional discount to their annual College fees (\$200 per calendar year).

The Arts	Enrolment in any of The Arts ATAR Courses
Humanities	Enrolment in ATAR English and/or Literature and two (2) other ATAR Humanities Courses
Health & Physical Education	Enrolment in ATAR Physical Education Studies and/or ATAR Health Studies. Selection for the <u>TEAM (Talented &amp; Elite Athletes- Mindarie)</u> <u>Program.</u>
Mathematics & Sciences	Enrolment in a minimum of three (3) ATAR Mathematics & Science Courses.
Technology & Enterprise	Enrolment in any of the ATAR Technology & Enterprise Courses and one (1) other Technologies Course.

	Please include any details of awards, film competitions, dance troupe participation, music recordings, Battle of the Bands etc.
Humanities	Six (6) pieces of work from across English and HASS disciplines. <i>At least one</i> of these should be an analytical essay in English.
Health & Physical Education	The HPE Scholarship winner will be selected from TEAM program applicants. Please complete the <u>application for TEAM</u> (also available on our website) in addition to this form.
Mathematics & Sciences	Applicants may be required to sit an entry test at the College. You will receive notification of the test date once your reports and personal statement have been assessed.
Technology & Enterprise	No specific documentation required. However, if you wish to include work that may support your application, you are welcome to do so.
